Our history

The story of Sika-Design begins in 1942, when Ankjær Andreasen produced the first batch of handmade baskets, lamps, flower tables and other smaller interior items made of rush and willow. In the 1950's the production was extended to include a series of handmade furniture made from rattan, and the company Sika-Design was firmly established. Our passion for rattan and craftmanship dates back several decades and makes us Scandinavia's oldest producer of rattan and wicker furniture.

3rd generation

Sika-Design is a danish family company with 3rd generation, Louise Andreasen in charge. Ankjær Andreasen's son, Knud Andreasen, took over the company in 1983, and Ankjær continued his daily inspections until his death in 1997. Louise and her father Knud have since 1996 worked side by side bringing Sika-Design into the new century with great designs, while never letting go of our strong heritage of great craftsmanship. In 2013 Louise Andreasen took over the company and became CEO of Sika-Design. Knud is still working in the company and is an important asset, as he is continuingly passing on the Sika-Design company culture and heritage to the next generations.

Core values

At Sika-Design we have a passion for rattan, craftmanship and sustainability. Rattan gives us endless possibilities because of its flexibility and as one of the most sustainable materials for furniture. We treasure rattan and its unique qualities to handcraft amazing furniture. Our mission is to manufacture furniture which can last for decades, both when it comes to design and durability.

Social responsibility

All Sika-Design's furniture are manufactured in our factories in Indonesia. Our products are made with care for the environment and the well-being of people. The production is committed to a healthy environmental policy and an ongoing focus on improving the working conditions.

Sika-Design is certified by ISO14001:2015 and SMETA by DNV-GL. This is your guarantee that we are committed to protect people and the environment. We have always been dedicated to these ideals and we were one of the first furniture companies in Denmark to be certified and started working systematically with them more than 10 years ago.







A passion for rattan Designs BY 3 GENERATIONS






Louise Andreasen (1971-)

Louise Andreasen is the 3rd generation to run Sika-Design. She has worked side by side with her father Knud since 1996 and she took over the ownership of the company and the role of CEO in 2015. Louise is very conscious about inheriting a company with a strong culture characterized by freedom with responsibility. She is determined to preserve and continue this culture created by her father and grandfather. Louise has from a very young age been passionate about furniture production and interior design. Her strong imprint in the company has been insisting to create furniture in the natural material rattan and to rejuvenate rattan furniture from iconic designers and architects.

Knud Andreasen (1948-)

Knud Andreasen took over his father's company in 1983. Over three decades, Knud has developed a strong worldwide distribution and made solid manufacturing partnerships in Indonesia and Malaysia. In 1989 he founded Sika-Design's associated company Cane-Line A/S and in 1991, he acquired the Danish competitor Horsnæs and merged it with Sika. Knud was a pioneer when he introduced the game changing material ArtFibre on the European market in the late 1990's. Knud has always insisted on great comfort and strength when designing and producing furniture. Especially furniture designed for hospitality has been one of Knud's core focus areas.





Ankjær Andreasen (1911-1997)


Ankjær Andreasen established the company Sika Møbler in 1942. He was a true entrepreneur at heart and had previously run a hotel, created an entire housing area and arranged spectacular motorcycle races. He was a man full of ideas and imagination. In the beginning Ankjær produced wicker baskets, lampshades and small pieces of rattan furniture at home, but the business quickly grew and in 1951 he established a cane and rattan manufacturing company on Funen in Denmark. In 1972, Ankjær went on a trip to the far east and when he returned, he had bought a piece of land and established a rattan furniture production in Malaysia which quickly grew to 150 men.

Our iconic designers PIONEERS WITHIN RATTAN AND FURNITURE DESIGN

Arne Jacobsen, Nanna & Jørgen Ditzel, R. Wengler, Franco Albini & Franca Helg, Viggo Boesen and Tove Kindt-Larsen were all pioneers of their time. They broke new ground when they made experimental shapes of the sturdy material rattan and wicker, creating sculptural and timeless icons. At Sika-Design we are proud to have acquired the rights for these iconic designs. It is very important for us to work closely with the descendants to ensure the design and quality. All our iconic furniture was originally made in rattan, but for our Exterior collection all the designs have been handmade in Aluminium and ArtFibre[®] for outdoor use.








Arne Jacobsen

Arne Jacobsen was a renowned danish architect, who first hoped to become a painter. He was later admitted to the Architecture School at the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts from 1924 to 1927. Still a student, in 1925 he participated in the Paris Art Deco fair, Exposition Internationale des Arts Décoratifs et Industriels Modernes, where he won a silver medal for his first furniture design.

In 1929, he won a Danish Architect's Association competition for designing the "House of the Future" which was built in full scale for the Housing and Building Exhibition in Forum Copenhagen. Arne Jacobsen was revered as one of the most visionary and progressive Danish architects of his time.





Nanna & Jørgen Ditzel

The Danish designer Nanna Ditzel, together with her husband Jørgen, exhibited their first furniture designs in Copenhagen, while they were still students at the Industrial Arts and Crafts College, Copenhagen. They quickly established their own design studio and started to work with wicker in cooperation with the renowned wicker worker R. Wengler in 1950. The rocking chair Nanny was one of the first chairs based on the idea of a chair with no legs.

For a short period, Nanna also studied under the leading danish furniture designer Kaare Klint at the Royal Danish Academy of Fine Art's furniture school. Among Nanna Ditzel's designs are textiles for Kvadrat and silverware for Georg Jensen.





Tove Kindt-Larsen

Tove Kindt-Larsen was together with her husband Edvard one of Denmark's most prominent designers from the 1930's to the 1960's. Tove was educated at the Academy of Fine Arts in Copenhagen and had already before her marriage to Edvard worked with furniture drawing.

Together with her husband they were a strong design-duo and their work was characterized by contrasts and simplicity, as well as a high sense of quality and appreciation of current trends. They covered areas such as architecture, furniture design, silverware and textiles.

Viggo Boesen

Viggo Boesen is a Danish architect who contributed to the Danish design aesthetics in the 1930's. From his workshop Viggo designed a number of rattan and upholstery furniture, which was constructed according to his philosophy: Furniture should have an organic flow and embrace the body smoothly and tenderly. They should be a delight to the eye, but also be solid and durable.

The Fox chair was the first of many furniture pieces from Viggo Boesen and with that he won the design competition, held by the Danish wicker-maker guild in 1936. His inspiring, imaginative designs made him unique and put him among the designers of the "Danish Golden Age."





Franco Albini & Franca Helg

Italian Franco Albini and Franca Helg started working together in 1952. Franco was an Italian Neo-Rationalist architect and designer, and he began his professional career working for Gio Ponti. He obtained three Compasso d'Oro awards, which is the most prestigious Italian design prize.

Franca was also an Italian designer and architect graduated from Politecnico di Milano. Franco and Franca were active both in the field of furniture, architectural planning and in industrial design. Together they designed many creations with the new forms of modernism.

Our passion for rattan has been with us since the beginning and even though our history begins with rattan for the interior, we have also been designing and producing furniture for exterior use for more than 15 years. Our Exterior collection is made with the same beautiful expression as our interior furniture and the same respect for the original design.

The collection is made of hand bend Aluminum frames and is hand wowen with ArtFibre[®], making the furniture perfect for being outside all year. For the season 2021 we are excited to present our new and extraordinary aluminum color Natural, which is hand painted to look like real rattan. In this way you can get the beautiful rattan look for your exterior furniture.



Charlottenborg BY ARNE JACOBSEN

Arne Jacobsen designed this charismatic lounge chair in 1936. He showcased it for the first time at the Charlottenborg spring exhibition in 1937 and since then named after the castle.

The chair was originally named A.J 237 and was part of a series of original rattan chairs. It is a known fact, that the Charlottenborg chair was one of Arne Jacobsen's favourite lounge chairs in his famous vacation home Knarken near Sejroebugten in Denmark.

The Paris chair was designed by Arne Jacobsen in 1929 for a competition published by The Basket Makers Association. When he later the same year exhibited with the famous "The House of the Future", the chair was displayed as a part of the interior design. Until World War II, the chair was produced by R. Wengler and it is known both as Fremtidens Stol, Skovsneglen and Paris Chair.

Hanging Egg by NANNA & JØRGEN DITZEL

The Hanging Egg Chair is a critically acclaimed design that has enjoyed praise worldwide ever since the distinctive sculptural shape was created by Nanna & Jørgen Ditzel in 1959. The chair is designed on the basis of the body and it is one of the first chairs based on the idea of integrating a shell on a frame as one piece.

It is a Scandinavian classic and is one of the most known iconic designs from Denmark. In 2014 Sika-Design acquired the manufacture rights after an Italian company. The Hanging Egg Chairs is commonly used for both private and hospitality projects by architects and designers all over the world.

Chill by NANNA DITZEL

The beautiful rattan lounge chair Chill, with complementary footstool, was designed in the late summer of 1961. It was the first piece of furniture Nanna Ditzel created after her husband's death in 1961. Chill is an almost sculptural installation that effortlessly integrates body and furniture. The chair along with the footstool ties an organic design language with minimalistic features and suggests indulgence and relaxation - whether it is for indoor or outdoor use. The original name was "Kaminstolen" and it was used in Nanna Ditzel's private vacation home for more than 40 years.

Madame by NANNA & JØRGEN DITZEL

In 1951 Nanna & Jørgen Ditzel designed the Madame chair. Like the Hanging Egg it is one of the first chairs based on the idea of integrating a shell on a frame as one piece. With a feminine and functional aesthetic, the Madame Chair is a prime example of Ditzel's work.

Tulip by tove kindt-larsen

The Tulip chair and was designed by Tove Kindt-Larsen and was originally produced by R. Wengler in the 1940's.

Belladonna & Ottoman By Franco Albini & Franca Helg

In 1951 the Italian duo Franco Albini & Franca Helg designed the Belladonna sofa and the Ottoman. The Belladonna has a very elegant expression with its fine open weave and the beautiful curved back. The construction gives the impression that the seat sits on a pedestal, which gives the sofa an almost majestic aura. The Ottoman truly distinguish itself as an all-round multipurpose furniture and is both sculptural and elegant.




Upholstery and cushions

Since the 1950's when Ankjær started his furniture production, we have developed customized cushions for all our models in our own facilities in Denmark. Our high-quality upholstery and seat cushions are made to order and can be chosen from a broad variety of highquality fabrics and styles – even your own fabric. We are also capable of making custom made cushions. If you have a special request or a specific need, feel free to contact us. We make cushions for interior and exterior use.

Materials & maintenance



TEMPOTEST FABRICS

Our Italian Tempotest[®] fabrics are treated with a special type of finish. During the treatment process, the finish is deposited not only on the surface of the fabric, but envelopes each individual fibre. This forms an impenetrable barrier without compromising the fabric's breathability.

The HI-Clean finishing makes Tempotest[®] fabrics water and oil repellent. It is also rotting proof and immune to the formation of mold and fungus.



TEAK TABLES & TOPS


Only premium sustainable plantation-grown teak from Indonesia is used for the manufacture of our teak tables. The features of premium grade teak are a straight grain structure, the absence of knots, splits or cracks and an even overall color. It will turn grey over time when used outside.

What is Indonesian Legal Wood?

All our teak tables carry the Indonesian Legal Wood logo. All teak wood sourcing is overseen by the Indonesian government. This means that no healthy tree too immature, or too small is removed from a forest.

MAINTENANCE: Wash with water mixed with mild soap and remove stains with a sponge or medium brush. If you wish to treat your teak furniture, we recommend using teak oil – be aware that this will make the wood darker!





GLASS TOPS

Our glass tops are made from 8 mm tempered glass. They are easy to clean and more durable than ordinary glass. It is important to handle it with care. A damaged edge or scratched surface can in exceptional cases cause the glass to crack suddenly. Avoid collisions from the side where it is most vulnerable.

MAINTENANCE: Wash with water mixed with mild soap and remove stains with a sponge or medium brush.



VERSALITE TOPS

Our versalite table tops are easy to maintain because of its smooth, scratch free and hygienic surface. These table tops are strong and stable. They are also resistant to all weather conditions which makes them the perfect choice for restaurants and hotels.

MAINTENANCE: Wash with water mixed with mild soap and remove stains with a sponge or medium brush.



ALU-RATTAN

Alu-Rattan is used in our Exterior and Alu Affäire collections. All our aluminium furniture is powder coated leaving a smooth finish and a vibrant color. The furniture is well-suited to be left outside all year long. It is easy to clean and is maintenance free.

MAINTENANCE: Wash with water mixed with mild soap and remove stains with a sponge or medium brush.



ARTFIBRE®

ArtFibre[®] is used in Exterior, Affäire, Alu Affäire & Georgia Garden. Our ArtFibre[®] is made of dyed hard-wearing polyethylene. It is ideal for outdoor use in any climate as it is temperature and UV-resistant. ArtFibre[®] is flexible and provides optimal comfort when woven. It has a strong structure that can maintain its shape for years on end.

MAINTENANCE: Wash with water mixed with mild soap and remove stains with a sponge or medium brush.
